LinkedIn Learning

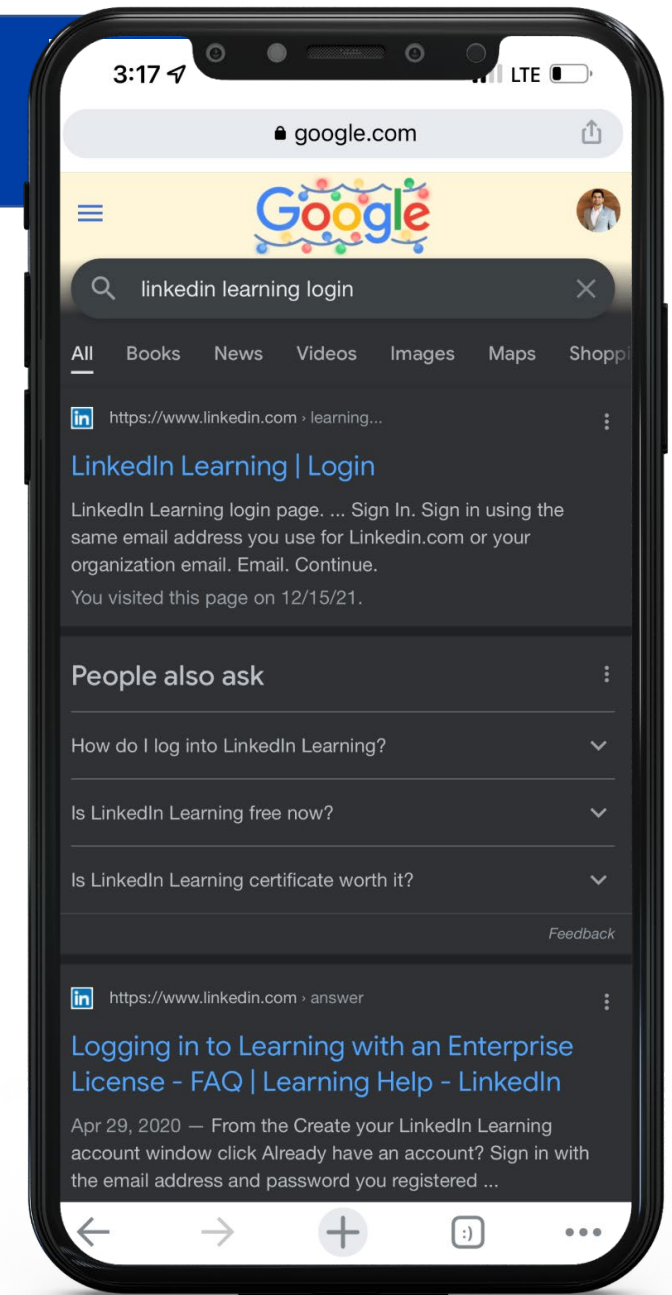


*LinkedIn Learning is an online educational platform that helps you discover and develop leadership, business, technology-related, and creative skills through expert-led course videos.*

# STEP 1.

## Google "LinkedIn Learning Login"

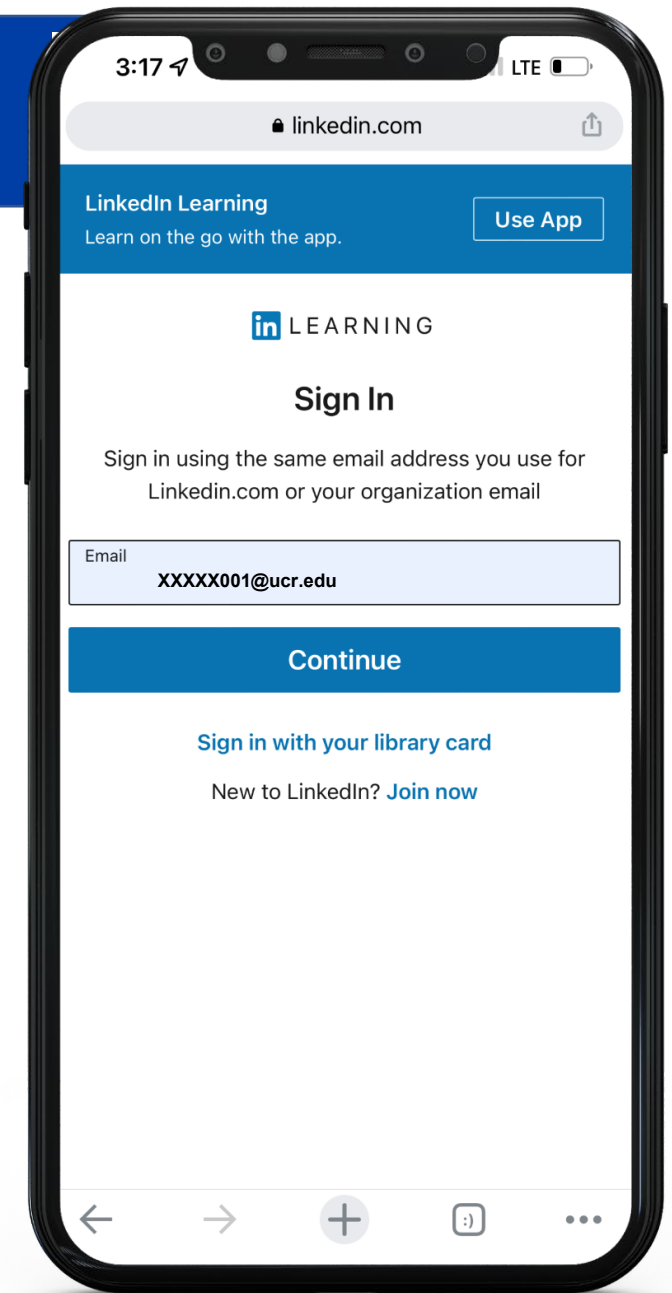
Search for "LinkedIn Learning" in your favorite browser.



# STEP 2.

## Login using your school Email

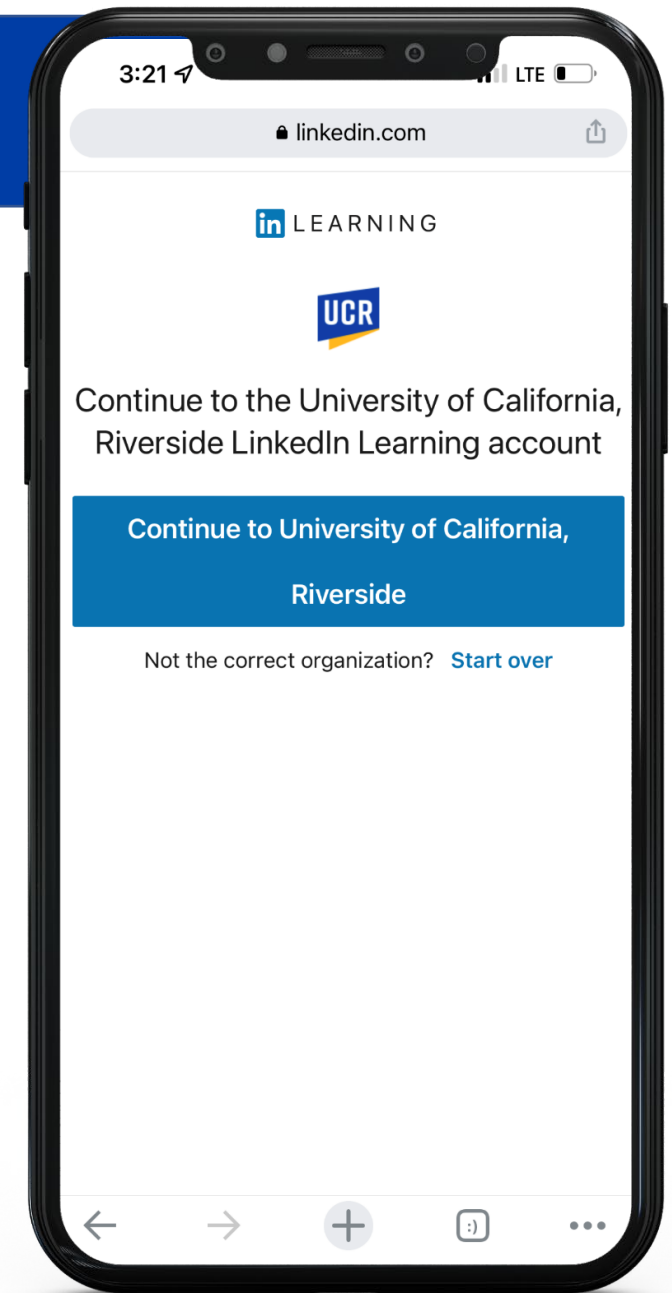
Use your **personal school email id (NetID)** (**xxx@ucr.edu**) and hit “sign in” or “continue”.



# STEP 3.

## Choose university (UCR) in the List

Find and click on **University of California Riverside** in the list.



# STEP 4.

## Login by using **UCR Net ID** and password

Use the same credentials you use to access the UCR school portal. *(authenticate pushed login request/passcode to validate username & password)*

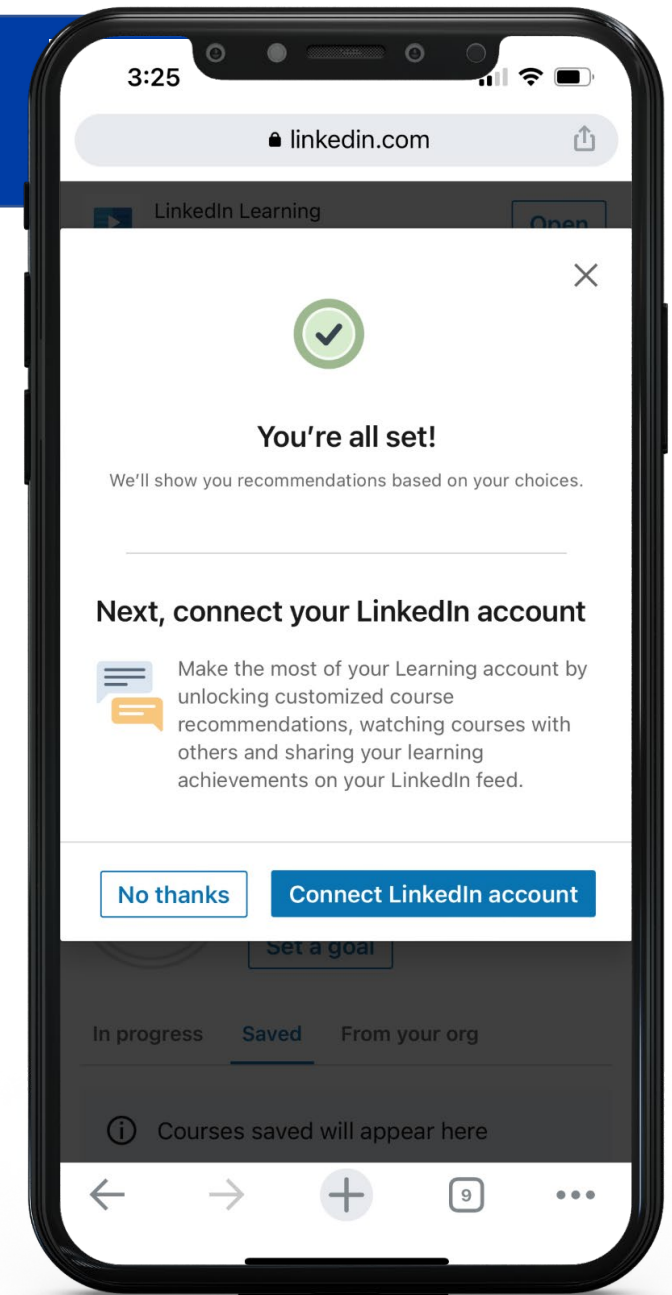


# STEP 5.

Now that you have access to LinkedIn Learning, **lets connect your existing LinkedIn account with it.** (optional)



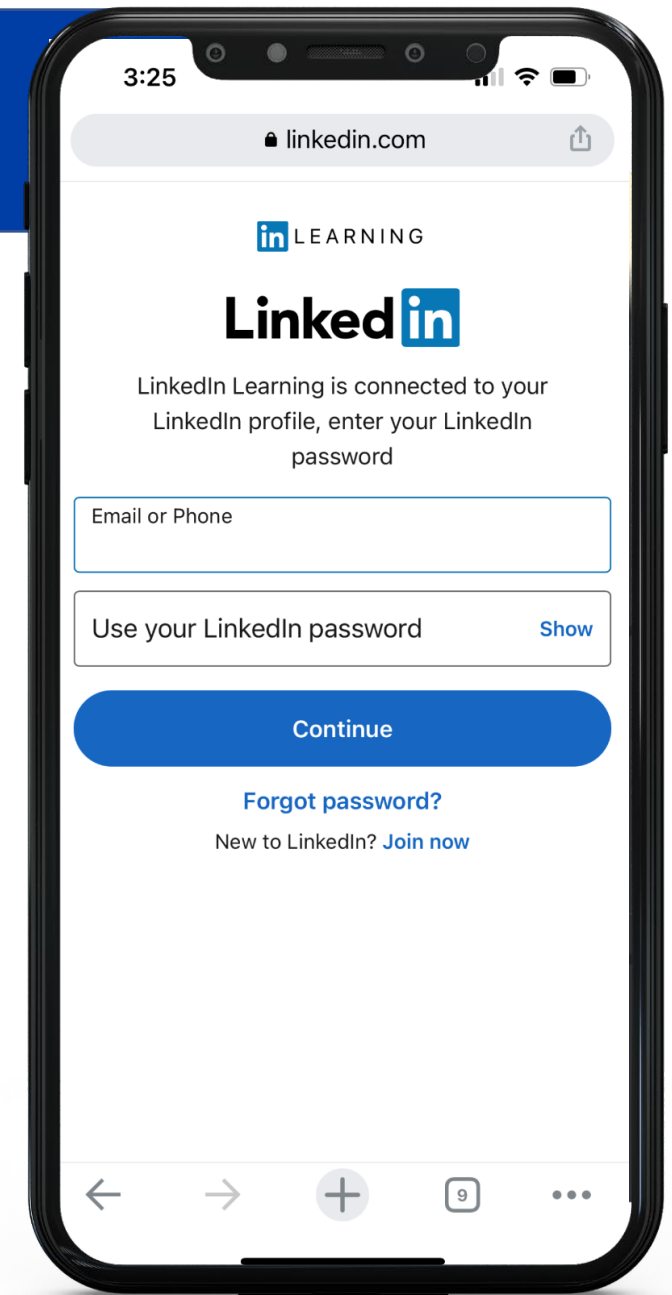
## STEP 6.

**OR**

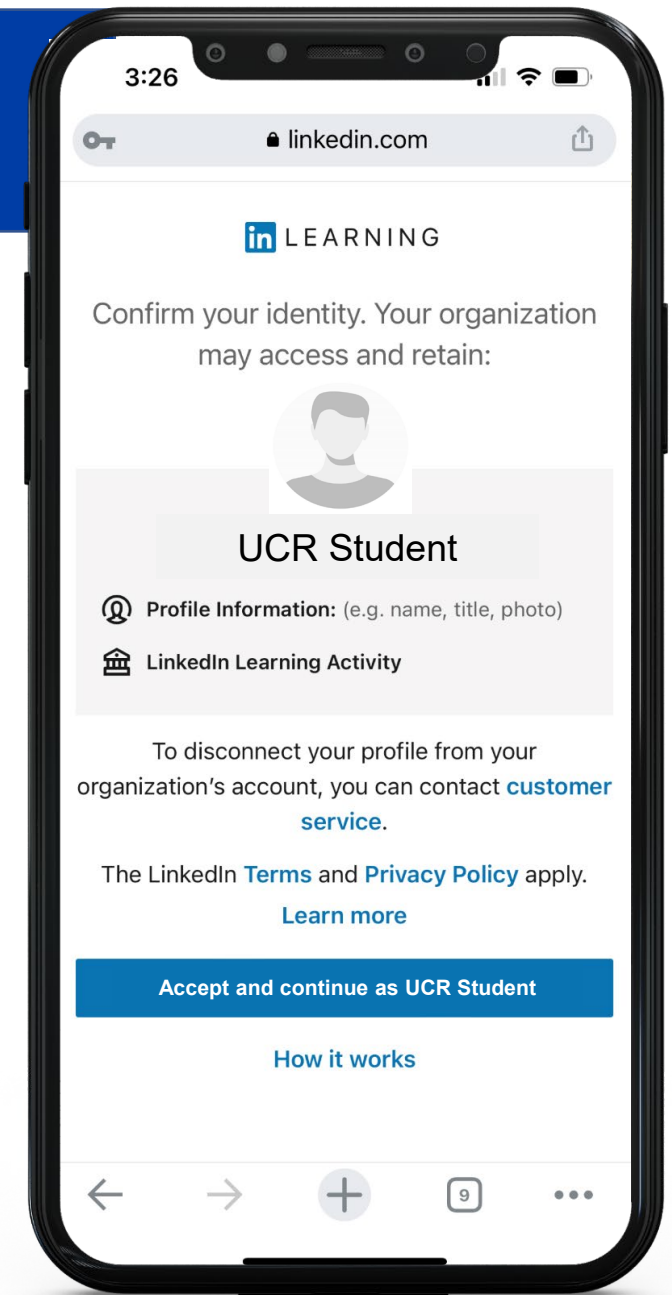
If you do not have an account, **create new** by clicking on **Join now** in the bottom.

## Accept the Terms & Conditions

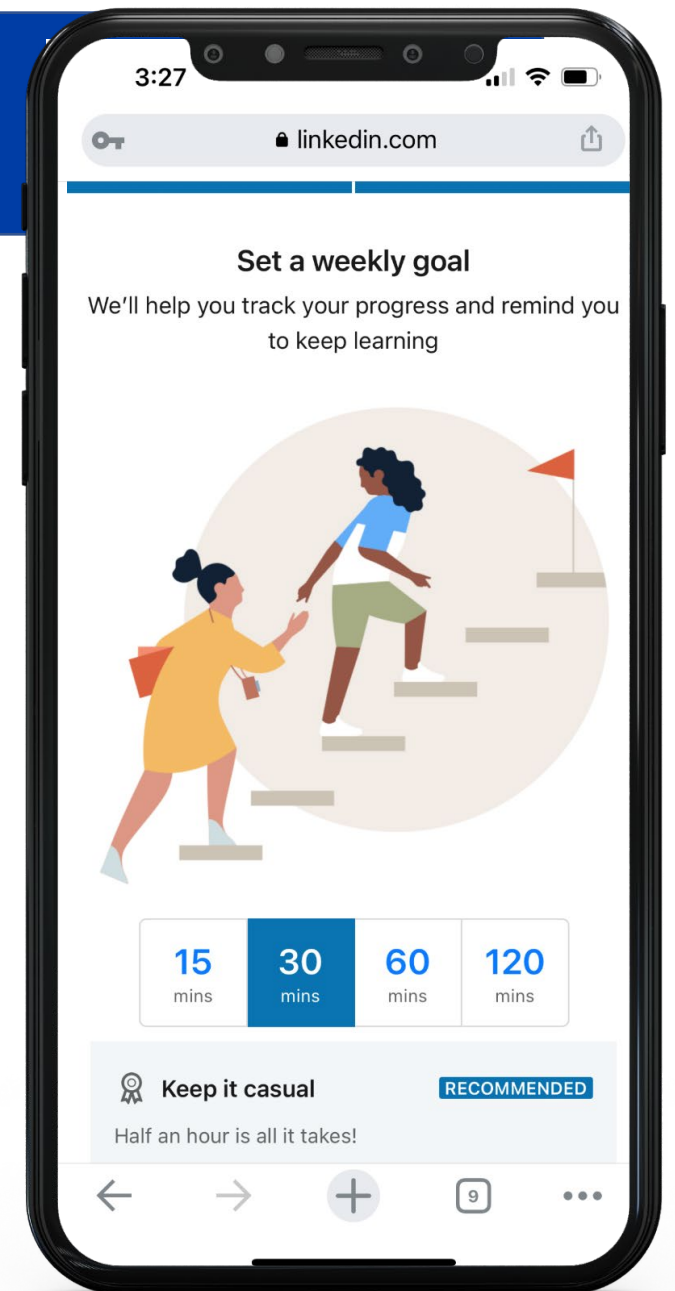
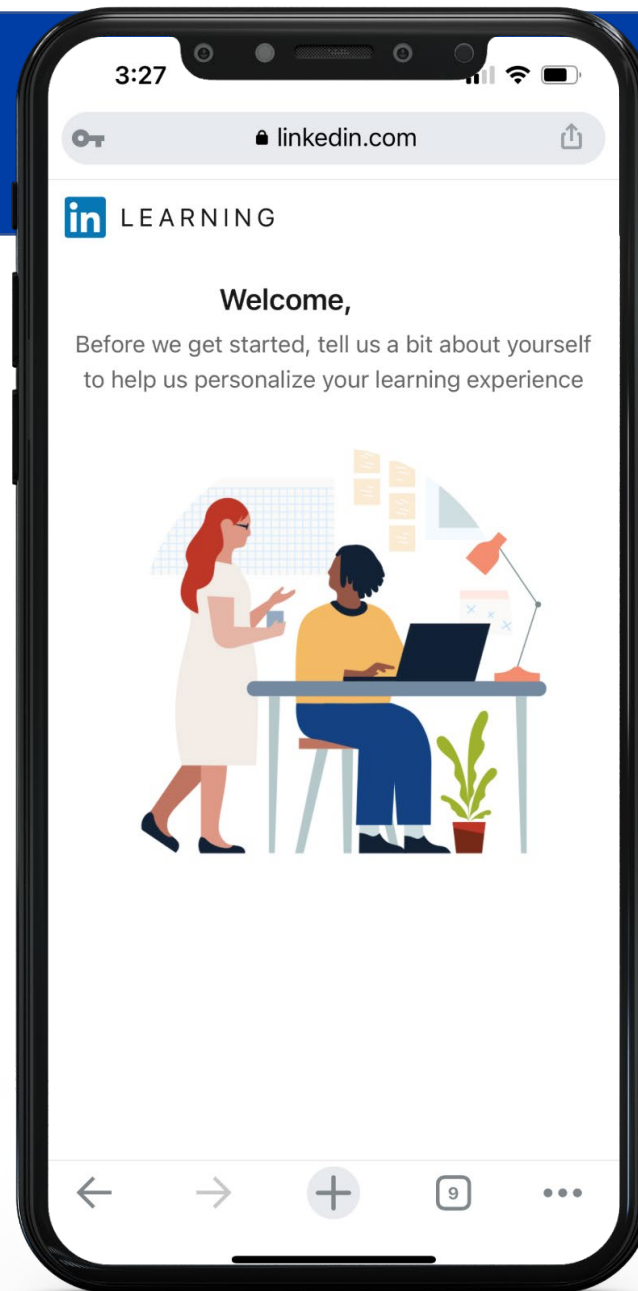
Make sure you see your name and picture on the screen. If it's you press **"Accept and continue as [ your name]"**
